
Destination Greater Victoria is honoured to be based on the traditional territory of the Lekwungen-speaking peoples, whose historical relationships with the land continue to this day.

# Sustainability

Destination Greater Victoria is the first Destination Marketing Organization in North America to achieve Climate Positive designation. Destination Greater Victoria is proudly certified Climate Positive by Ostrom Climate and Synergy Enterprises. In March 2023, Greater Victoria became Biosphere Certified, a prestigious tourism designation. Seventeen of our members are Biosphere Certified, including the Victoria Conference Centre—the most of any North American Destination. A further 47 members are Biosphere Committed.

When you visit Victoria, you're met with green initiatives right out of the gate! New to the Victoria International Airport, YYJ, is a native species pollinator garden with more than 2,000 flora planted in 1,100 square metres of garden to help pollinators thrive.




### **Accessibility**

Victoria recently completed an accessibility audit to ensure travellers of all abilities can enjoy this beautiful city. What makes Greater Victoria special is the ease with which travellers of all abilities can access our world class activities, luxurious accommodations and elegant dining options.

### Victoria International Airport Launches Accessibility Initiative MagnusCards

Victoria Airport Authority (VAA), in partnership with Magnusmode, has launched a new accessibility initiative, MagnusCards®, to assist travellers. MagnusCards is a smartphone application available for iOS and Android, offering travellers step-by-step visuals, audio, and text how-to's to make everyday activities more manageable for people of all abilities. This initiative helps to improve the passenger experience at Victoria International Airport (YYJ) by reducing barriers for travel and ensuring that everyone that uses our airport can navigate their journey safely and efficiently.

### **Explore Songhees**

"ay? skwéčal "good day" The Songhees Nation welcomes all visitors to Lekwungen Traditional Territory to partake in meaningful Indigenous cultural experiences. The Songhees Wellness Centre is the cultural hub where people and traditions come to meet. It offers incredible views, an art gallery + cafe and full-service event facilities for over 600 people.

Established in 2008, the Seven Signs of the Lekwungen is an interpretive walkway along the Inner Harbour and surrounding areas that honours the art, history and culture of the Coast Salish people who have resided in the Victoria area for hundreds of years.

### **Porter Airlines**

Porter Airlines began service between Toronto Pearson International Airport (YYZ) and Victoria International Airport (YYJ) with the new Embraer E195-E2 aircraft in September 2023.

### **Kenmore Air**

Kenmore Air provides connectivity to Victoria from Seattle and the San Juan Islands. New for 2024, Kenmore Air launched seaplane service between Friday Harbor Marina and downtown Victoria, while maintaining their existing seaplane connection between Seattle (Lake Union & Lake Washington) and Victoria's Inner Harbour.






### Helijet

Helijet International announced plans to add Canada's first order for an electric, vertical-takeoff aircraft to add to its fleet of passenger and cargo helicopters. The ALIA aircraft will provide quick, quiet, and more efficient landings and takeoffs from hospitals and other emergency zones. Anticipated by 2026 for private and commercial flights.

### Harbour Air

Harbour Air is actively moving to transform to an all-electric fleet.

In April 2024, Harbour Air shared that they had signed a letter of intent with magniX to purchase 50 magni650 electric engines—a significant step in its commitment to sustainable aviation.

### 100th Anniversary Victoria Harbour Migratory Bird Sanctuary

2023 marked the 100th year anniversary of the Victoria Harbour Migratory Bird Sanctuary. The sanctuary is the oldest and largest in BC, along with Esquimalt Lagoon and Shoal Harbour Bird Sanctuary.

### **HOTELS & ACCOMMODATION**

#### **Rosemead House**

Esquimalt's Old English Inn will reopen as Rosemead House following extensive restoration, for full, luxury hotel service this fall 2024. The newly restored hotel will feature 28 unique guest rooms, suites, the signature Janevca Kitchen and Lounge, Salt and Ivy Spa, and more. The historic property was originally designed by architect Samuel Macclure, best known for developing the Government House (with Francis Rattenbury) and Hatley Castle. Janevca Kitchen and Lounge will open to the public in the summer of 2024, to set the stage for Rosemead House.





### **Huntingdon Hotel & Suites**

After completing renovations to more than 38 loft rooms this spring 2024, Huntingdon Manor Hotel rebranded to Huntingdon Hotel & Suites. The loft rooms are new products, and they are quite different than our other rooms.

### Coast Victoria Hotel & Marina by APA

Coast Victoria guest room renovations commenced to offer guests an elevated Refreshingly Local™ experience with a focus on comfort, intuitively designed rooms and suites, and unparallelled service. Completed spring 2024.





### **Fairmont Empress**

The newly redesigned Fairmont Gold at Fairmont Empress, the brand's exclusive 'hotel within a hotel' experience, re-opened in summer 2023, which also marked the Empress' 115th anniversary. The expanded Fairmont Gold Lounge is located on the first floor of the heritage building with a private lounge and terrace that features dedicated concierge service. Fairmont Gold is designed to fulfill the needs of discerning travellers, ensuring their stay is nothing short of unforgettable. The reimagined Gold Floor and guestrooms celebrate both the history and natural beauty of the west coast, and elevates the historical property further into a new era of modern luxury.

### Wild Renfrew Seaside Cottages NEW FOREST VIEW STUDIO

In January, 2024, Wild Renfrew introduced a news Forest View Studio. With unique and special features such as an outdoor shower, outdoor jetted tub, private patio and a gas fire-pit., this Studio makes for a vacation never to be forgotten. This studio sits on the edge of a little forest, located away from all of the other units, granting a private and peaceful evening and night.



### **New Hotel in Old Town**

Victoria Council has approved a project to overhaul two heritage buildings in Old Town to make way for a 139-room hotel. UVic Properties and Chard Development plan to use the site to build a Hyatt-centric, branded hotel covering almost a full block of Broad Street. The proposal preserves the front and rear walls and parts of the side walls of the Duck's historic building, as well as an original rock wall of the Carriage Factory, which dates to 1874.

### Abigail's Hotel

Tucked away in a gorgeous neighbourhood just three blocks from downtown Victoria. Abigail's Hotel mixes historic charm and modern luxury and recently expanded to add eight new luxury guestrooms.

Abigail's Hotel has received outstanding recognition including #2 Hotel in Canada in the 2024 Trip Advisor Traveler's Choice Awards.





### The Vic, Ascend Hotel Collection

Opened in 2023, the Vic Hotel is a boutique hotel located near the stunning Selkirk Trestle, featuring upscale, spacious, apartment-style suites with rainfall showers, refrigerators, microwaves, and kitchenettes. Also offering pet-friendly Gorge Waterway accommodations.

### **HAVN Saunas**

HAVN is a floating park-like environment on the edge of Victoria's Inner Harbour. Lush outdoor green spaces, cold pools, hot tubs, an indoor lounge space, and hand-built saunas provide a vibrant self-care experience. Located on a 44-meter marine barge built in 1943 that was originally used as a floating wartime workshop for welders and other tradesman.





#### Wildwood Saunas

Wildwood Saunas recently found a new home at the scenic Bilston Creek Lavender Farm in Metchosin – July 2023. This relaxing 90-minute wood-burning Sauna and Cold Plunge Cycle features cold plunge tubs, a designated relaxation area, and cold outdoor showers, each with a window framing the views of Metchosin's lush forest.

### **GATTRACTIONS**

### The Flavour Trails extend to Greater Victoria's Westshore

This July, a new route was added to the Flavour Trails, self-guided agritourism itineraries. Barns, Beaches and Beyond showcases makers, farmers and producers in Langford, Metchosin and Sooke. Whether the new trail is explored as a loop, or as a collection of experiences, farm-fresh options abound. Highlights include a delightful brunch featuring locally sourced ingredients and an African twist, a charming lavender farm, delightful sugar shack, friendly barnyard buddies, and a blacksmith forge. The Flavour Trails also offer itineraries on the Saanich Peninsula and Southern Gulf Islands.





### Victoria Butterfly Garden – Juvenile Cuvier's Dwarf Caiman

The Victoria Butterfly Gardens proudly announced a significant addition to its jungle experience with the acquisition of a Cuvier's Dwarf Caiman, the smallest living New World crocodilian. Javier, the caiman, is being cared for by the Victoria Butterfly Gardens on behalf of Environment and Climate Change Canada.

### **Underground Donut Tour**

In August 2023, Victoria's newest food tour launched with a focus exclusively on everyone's favourite pastry – donuts! Taking you to four of the best donut shops in Victoria, learn about the history of each of the shops, the neighbourhood and greater Victoria while enjoying a delicious treat.
