### Vendor Participation Terms and Conditions / Cancellation Policy

- Upon vendor acceptance, your payment is due within 72 hours of being notified. If payment is not received your space will automatically be removed from the list.
- Vendors may only sell products listed in their application unless prior approval is obtained.
- Vendors agree the photography they submit will be shared in Destination Greater Victoria's marketing channels. Also, as a vendor, table displays and products will be photographed for current and future social media and marketing including our website.
- Vendors understand they are responsible for obtaining all permits, licenses, insurance, and approvals reasonably required to sell products and to do onsite food sampling which is approved by Island Health.
- Vendors are responsible for the collection of sales tax and credit/debit services.
- Vendors are legally liable for any negative consequences resulting from the purchase or consumption of their goods.
- Load-in instructions and onsite placement will be specific and vendors must be market-ready 30 minutes prior to the event. Vendors will be provided with a set-up and tear-down schedule before the event. At the closing of the event, vendors are required to leave their vendor space clear and free of garbage and recycling.
- Vendors must remain set up in their spaces until the close of the event.
- Signage should be on your table and not large banners that overflow/block natural light into your neighbours' space.
- If any government agency, court, person or commercial body orders sale of your products cease, you will immediately comply with this order.
- As a vendor, you will indemnify Destination Greater Victoria, its directors, members, partners, employees, contractors and volunteers for any loss, fine, penalty, judgement, legal fees, and expenses reasonably connected with your failure to comply with the terms of this agreement or any liability, negligence, gross negligence or injury resulting from your products, actions, conduct, booth setup, display or trade activities.
- Destination Greater Victoria will be excused of any performance obligations in the event of a disastrous occurrence outside the control of an act of God (fires, explosions, earthquakes, hurricane, natural disasters, global pandemic, flooding, storms, or infestation), or War, Invasion or other Hostility (whether declared or not), or any hazardous situation created outside the control of Destination Greater Victoria such as a riot, disorder, nuclear leak or explosion, or act or threat of terrorism.

- Destination Greater Victoria is not liable for any damage or loss whatsoever, arising from any cause, nor for any loss incurred by reason of failure of The Vendor to obtain such insurance or failure of such insurance to cover any loss.
- Failure to comply with the above terms will result in the cancellation of your application.

### **Cancellation Policy**

Market Cancellation: If the market is canceled due to unforeseen events, \$50 of your vendor fee will be retained to cover event costs.

Vendor Cancellation: If you, the vendor, cancel within four (4) weeks of the event, no refund will be provided. If you cancel prior to four (4) weeks out from the event, a 50% refund will be issued.
